# **Rules Nordic Championships**

SCF Para-Cycling Pursuit Road Race apply. Participation is at your own risk. Technical inspection of bicycles and other equipment may occur in connection with the call for all classes.

# **Eligibility to Participate**

Nordic Championships is open to cyclist who hold a license at the end of the regular registration day.

# Registration

<u>Registration is via Sportstiming.se</u> Cost 500 SEK regardless of class. No later than Friday 20 June 2025.

# Equipment

All handcycles must have safety bar (collision protection). Recumbent hand cyclist must have a mirror.

# PM

Published one week before the competition. Any adjustment will be stated there.

Immediately after race finished. Mandatory for 1 – 3 placed.

## Chip

We will use two chips on each bike, chips from Elite Timing for TV broadcast and Mylaps for showing information on a screen with information to the cyclist. These will be given in conjunction with the issuance of bib number. These are mandatory. For a non-returned chip, a charge of SEK 1500 will be charged.

## Award ceremony

Takes place after race finished. Medals for the three-prize winner in both classes. Cyclists must be wearing competition clothing or approved representation clothing at the ceremony.






## **Competition course**


